Standard registration

Total points for the 3 years needs to be a minimum of at least 250 points to enable re-registration without further assessment of competence. Of the 250 points, a minimum of 50 need to be from the last 12 months.

Registration (E)

Total points for leaders with an Experienced classification (E) needs to be a minimum of 120 points with a minimum of 36 points from leading the activity at the registration level and a minimum of 36 points from the emergency response category.
